## SIZE GUIDE

We have a selection of assorted boiler suits and coveralls available to loan.

## To find your size follow these steps:

1. Find your chest size.

Measure around the fullest part of your chest and use the chart to find your chest size.

CHEST

| Measurement (cm) | Size |
| :---: | :---: |
| $100-110$ | 1 |
| $111-120$ | 2 |
| $121-130$ | 3 |
| $131-140$ | 4 |
| $141-150$ | 5 |
| $151-160$ | 5 |

2. Find your body size.

Measure in a vertical line from where your shoulder meets your neck to where your leg meets your body.

BODY

| Measurement (cm) | Size |
| :---: | :---: |
| $74-80$ | A |
| 81-85 | B |
| 86-90 | C |
| 91-95 | D |
| 96-100 | E |

3. Combine the chest number with the body
 letter. For example, 3E or 5B.
4. Select your size from the dropdown menu. If your size is unavailable select the next size up in either/both chest and body.

## A NOTE ON LEG LENGTH:

Leg length is generally not too important because if the boilersuit or coverall is a bit short or too long we can unroll/ roll the legs. However, if you have very long legs please let us know as we have some boiler suits that are much 'longer' than others.
